
ACT/SAT Score

Complete and pass course.

Cambridge International Examinations

Cambridge International Examination classes are part of the comprehensive program toward the Cambridge University Diploma. The high school A and AS Level courses, available only through approved Cambridge International Schools, provide students the opportunity to earn postsecondary credit

Dual Enrollment

Classes are taken on the high school or college campus. Classes on campus includes English, math classes and TCAT & CTE (Mechatronics, EMS, Machining, Welding, Cosmetology, MLR, and Collision Repair) classes. Courses can also be taken on Cleveland State Community College and Lee University campuses. TVEC classes are also available.
