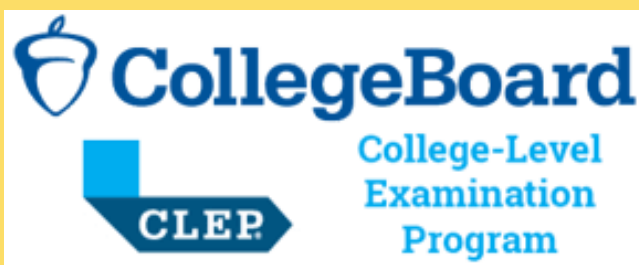
## ACT/SAT Score

earn a composite score of 21 or higher on the ACT or a 1060 or higher on the SAT



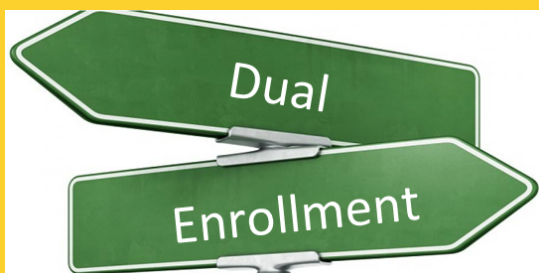
## EPSO: Advanced Placement (AP) Examinations

## EPSO: College Level Examination Program

Earn a passing score of 50 or higher on exam



## EPSO: Dual Enrollment

Complete and pass course.



## EPSO: Local Dual Credit

Complete course and attempt exam.



## EPSO: Statewide Dual Credit

Complete course and attempt exam.



## Industry Certifications

Earn passing score on exam and/or complete licensure requirements.

### Advanced Placement (AP) Examinations

The College Board's Advanced Placement (AP) Program provides an opportunity for high school students to experience postsecondary-level coursework across multiple subjects.

### College Level Examination Program

### Dual Enrollment

Classes are taken on the high school or college campus. Classes on campus includes English, math classes and CTE (Mechatronics and EMS) classes. Courses can also be taken on Cleveland State Community College and Lee University campuses. TVEC classes are also available.

Natural Resource Management, Digital Electronics, Mechatronics Classes, A/V Production III, Computer Applications, Business Management, Accounting I and II, Teaching as a Profession III, Health Science Focus, Lifespan and Family Studies, Networking, Coding II, Criminal Justice III, Entrepreneurship, Marketing Management, and Engineering Design II, Psychology and Chemistry.
